

Summer 2018 Semester Possible Course Session Slots

The grid below shows some examples of possible ways to split the summer term. For example, at first Tuesday is shown split into 3 4-week periods but you could also propose a 6-week course to run either the first or last half of the semester. Thursday is first shown as two 6-week slots but you could also propose a 4-week or 6 week. These are all just suggestions. The random placement of holidays causes some stand-alone days that might be good for special events – not that a special event must be on those days. This calendar is meant to offer clarity and not confusion, and help you picture when would work best for you to offer your course.
